It is impossible to put out a racing calendar for 2014, as well as an overnight purse structure and a stakes schedule, until the thoroughbred sector is told how much money will be available for this year. Everyone involved understands that time is of the essence, but taking an unfair split of the money is not going to happen, which is why these negotiations are taking longer than expected. The racing groups are fighting for the horsemen and I hope everyone can remain patient until the final decision comes down.
