B.C. RACING LEGEND PASSES AWAY

The local horsemen's fraternity lost one of the all-time greats as R.W. (Bobby) Hall passed away of natural causes last Wednesday at the age of 85.

Bobby was most noted for being the part-owner and trainer of arguably the best BC bred ever, George Royal. His commemorative statue still stands proudly in the centre of the paddock at Hastings Racecourse. He also trained 1971 Horse-of-the-Year Timber Music as well as numerous stakes winners; Ky Look, Desert Fire, Big Brac and Screaming Sue, just to name a few.

A Celebration of Life will be held on Wednesday, July 29th at Emerald Acres - (441 - 272nd Street Aldergrove), dubbed by Bob's wife Annie "the home that George Royal built". The service will begin at 4 p.m.

Hastings will be honouring Bobby Hall prior to the running of the first race on Saturday at 1:50 p.m.
