We are less than a month away from the opening day of the 2012 thoroughbred racing season at Hastings Racecourse. The horse population continues to rise with just under 600 on the backstretch. The worktab has been impressive with a total 331 different horses working last week. Of that number, 155 have worked a half-mile or farther, which would enable those horses to be ready for the races on April 14th. An additional 153 have worked three-eighths this week and some of those could conceivably be ready for opening day as well. We also expect to see another 100 horses return from the U.S. that will be ready for the first condition book.
